She is not asking for any more money or spending any more money she is just moving it for other purposes. The Finance Director just wanted to clarify this with Council. Deliberations ended. RESOLUTION 24-074, RECOGNIZING THE VILLAGES DONATION TO THE CHRISTMAS IN THE PARK EVENT.

WHEREAS, in recent years Council has committed to help defray the costs of putting on the annual Christmas in the Park event, a festival that celebrates the holiday season and is enjoyed by many residents of the Village and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Budget for the event was \$3,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council, Village of West Jefferson, County of Madison, State of Ohio, with a majority of duly elected members therefore concurring as follows:

SECTION I: Council herby authorizes a \$3,000.00 donation to West Jefferson Christmas in the Park event.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.

RESOLUTION 24-075, CLARIFYING THE LEGAL LEVEL OF CONTROL AND THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE'S AUTHORITY TO MOVE FUNDS WITHIN THE APPROVED ANNUALLY ESTABLISHED APPROPRIATIONS.

WHEREAS, annually the Village Council adopts the appropriation ordinance, and this ordinance provides the "legal level of control" for any changes, which can only be made by Village Council, which is presented at the Fund and then by Departments that are subdivided into Personnel, Operating and Other;

WHEREAS, in addition, Village Management, during the budgeting process presents detail to Council at the fund, program, activity and object level. These documents are used by Management to justify to Council the requests for funds and is only presented for informational purposes and not to determine the legal level of control. An appropriate official of Management has the authority to request that the Finance Director move funds within a Fund and then by Department and within the categories of Personnel, Operating and Other.

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance is given the authority to allocate or re-allocate funds within the legally adopted appropriations as described above (within a Fund and then within a Department and within the categories of Personnel, Operating and Other).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council, Village of West Jefferson, County of Madison, state of Ohio with the required number of duly elected members therefor concurring as follows.

SECTION I: The appropriation process is a function of the legislative authority that must be performed by those specific individuals elected to fulfill that responsibility.

<u>SECTION II</u> In determining the legal level of control, auditors will use the level of detail set forth in the Village's Appropriation Ordinance.

<u>SECTION III:</u> The Director of Finance is given the authority to allocate or re-allocate funds within the legally adopted appropriations as described above (within a Fund and then by Department and within the categories of Personnel, Operating and Other).
